CONDUCTOR BIO

April M. Kite,

Band Director at Edythe J. Hayes Middle School in Lexington Kentucky, is currently in her 18th year of teaching and her 10th year in Fayette County Public Schools. Prior to her appointment in Fayette County, Dr. Kite spent four years at the University of Kentucky teaching Elementary Music Methods and pursuing a Masters and PhD in Music Education. As part of her doctoral dissertation, Dr. Kite traveled to Japan where she conducted research entitled *A Comparison of Instrumental Music Education in the United States and Japan*. In addition, Dr. Kite served four years as Director of Bands at LaRue County Middle School and Assistant Director of Bands at LaRue County High School.

In 2011, Dr. Kite was selected KMEA District 7 Middle School Teacher of the Year. Dr. Kite is a member of the Music Educator National Conference, Phi Beta Mu Honorary Music Fraternity, and the Kentucky Music Educators Association. A native of LaRue County, Kentucky, she resides in Lexington with her husband Bill Kite, Director of Bands at Henry Clay High School, and their sons William, Luke and daughter Ella.

Lois U. Wiggins,

Band Director at Edythe J. Hayes Middle School in Lexington, Kentucky, has taught for 31 years in Kentucky, Tennessee and Indiana. Ms. Wiggins received a Bachelor of Science in Music Education from Austin Peay State University, a Master of Music Education from the University of Georgia, and a Rank I in Secondary Education from Western Kentucky University.

Ms. Wiggins is a past (2015-16) Kentucky Music Educators Association State Band Chair, as well as Band Content Area Leader for the Fayette County Public Schools. She is a member and Associate Conductor of the Lexington Brass Band and Co-Conductor of the Central Kentucky Youth Repertory Orchestra. She has guest conducted honor bands and adjudicated at concert band, marching band and solo & ensemble festivals throughout Tennessee and Kentucky. Ms. Wiggins has also served as a clinician at the KMEA In-Service Conference and the Tapestry Multicultural Conference. Her professional affiliations include Phi Beta Mu Band Masters Fraternity, the National Band Association, Women Band Directors National Association, Sigma Alpha Iota & Phi Delta Kappa.

Ms. Wiggins is a 2016 Grammy Music Educator Award National Finalist and received the International Women's Brass Conference "Beacon Award" in 2015. She was recognized by Phi Beta Mu as "Outstanding Young Band Director in Kentucky" in 1992 and "Outstanding Bandmaster in 2010. Ms. Wiggins was named KMEA Middle School Teacher of the year in 2000.
