## CONDUCTOR BIOGRAPHIES

### Kerry Evans

*Kerry Evans is currently in his 12th year as the director at Madison Middle School. Mr. Evans comes to Madison Middle from Eastern Kentucky University where he earned a BME and a MM. While at EKU, he was a horn student of Dr. Mick Sehmman and conducting student of Dr. Joe Allison, while serving as the Band Graduate Assistant.*

*Bands under his direction consistently receive distinguished ratings at the KMEA large group assessment and Music in the Parks events. They were invited to perform at the 2011 UK Middle School Invitational, and the 2013 KMEA State Convention.*

*Mr. Evans has been recognized as KMEA District 11 Middle School teacher of the year in 2009 and the University of Kentucky as "A teacher who made a difference" in 2011. In 2013, Mr. Evans was voted Madison County teacher of the year. Mr. Evans has also served as a guest conductor for various honor bands across the state, Judged numerous KMEA Solo and Ensemble and Large Group events, and has served as KMEA District 11 president. Currently he is serving as the KMEA State Middle School Band Chair. He is a member of PHI MU ALPHA SINFONIA. Kerry resides in Richmond with his wife Kim.*

### Perry Ralenkotter

*Perry A. Ralenkotter began his teaching career in 1988 at McCleskey Middle School in Cobb County, Georgia. This school fed into Lassiter, Sprayberry and Pope High Schools. In 1991 he began his career at S-DMS with 140 students. Within four years the program had grown to 445 students in grades six through eight. The Advanced, Concert, Explorer and Jazz bands at S-DMS have consistently received superior ratings at the Indiana State School Music Association festival and at other local festivals.*

*The Advanced Band has also been awarded a Superior with Distinction four times at ISSMA Concert Festival most recently in 2015, 2013, 2009 and 2003. The Advanced Band is the only second year ensemble in Group I to achieve this. On January 14, 2006 the S-DMS Advanced Band performed at the Indiana Music Educators Conference in Indianapolis. Mr. Ralenkotter is a director of middle school bands at the Stephen Collins Foster summer music camp at Eastern Kentucky University. It is the third longest running summer music camp in the nation. He has been featured twice as School Band and Orchestra's 50 directors who make a difference.*

*Mr. Ralenkotter is active as a clinician and adjudicator in the region and is a founder of the St. Leon All Star Band. In December of 2005 he was invited to present at the Midwest Band and Orchestra Clinic to discuss recruiting beginning band students. He presented again in 2011 to discuss the impact of NCLB and budget cuts on the arts. Mr. Ralenkotter is a Yamaha clinician where he works with school systems and music programs on recruiting, retention and support for the arts. *Mr. Ralenkotter is a native of Florence, Kentucky. He attended the University of Kentucky where he studied trumpet under the direction of Vincent DiMartino. Mr. Ralenkotter completed his student teaching with Dr. J. Steven Moore, the then director of bands at Lafayette High School in Lexington, Kentucky. He completed a Master of Music in Music Education degree at the University of Kentucky in 2003. He has pursued a D.M.A. at Boston University. Mr. Ralenkotter enjoys distance running and triathlon. He is a member of NEA, ISSMA, Phi Mu Alpha, and USAT.*

*He is married to Beverly and has four children, Matthew, Andrew, Lea and Ian. They reside in Union, Kentucky.*
